# Introduction

The Data Exchange is an innovative and intuitive suite of applications (reports) which display data reported in the Data Exchange.

Refer to the Data Exchange translator below to find out more about the terms used in Data Exchange.

#### Table 1 – Qlik translator

QLIK TERM	DESCRIPTION
Арр	Is the report name.
Drill	Click to drill down into the selected item.
Hub	When Qlik starts up, you arrive at the hub. The hub is where you find all the apps you have access rights to use.
Sheet	Is a page or screen.
Snapshot	Is a screenshot of a graph or image.
Story	Is a presentation.
Visualization	Is a chart or table that presents data in an easy to read way.
